What is Remembrance Day?

Each year on the eleventh hour, of the eleventh day, on the eleventh month we have a two minutes silence, but why do we have this, some of you may ask. Well, the official title of this day is called 'Armistice Day' or it's sometimes known as Remembrance Day. It marks the exact time and day that the First World War ended. We have a two minutes silence to remember all the people who died during the war and all those people who have died in any war since. The Sunday closest to the eleventh is also known as Remembrance Sunday. This year it falls on Sunday 13th November. On this Sunday many people from across the country attend a special ceremony at the Cenotaph (a special monument in London to honour all the people who have died in the wars).
