

Parent Activity Afternoons

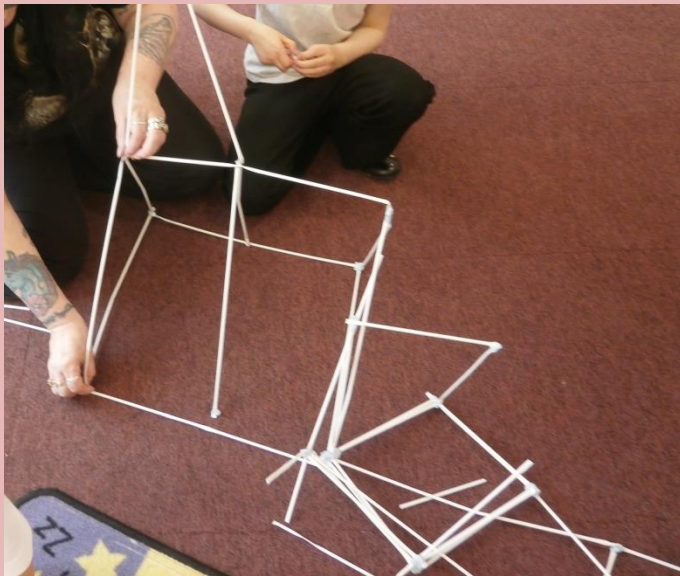
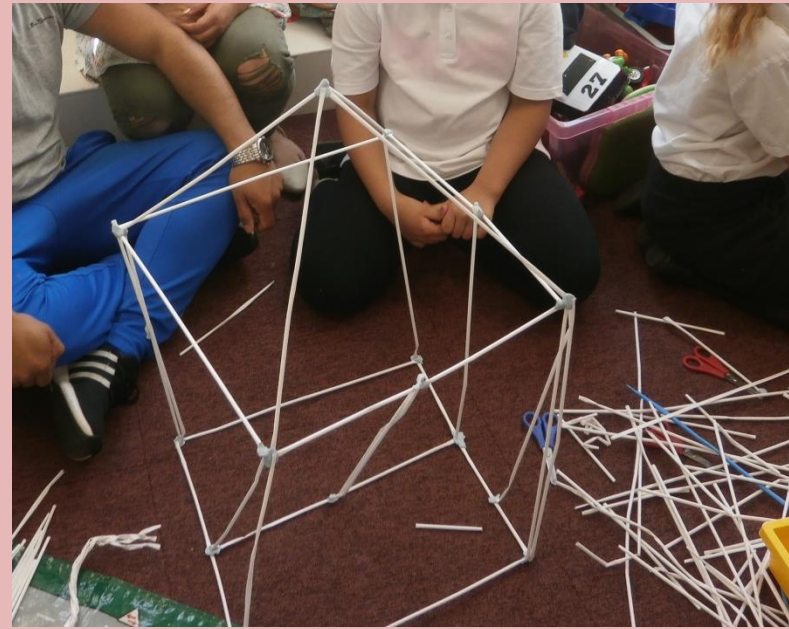
Over the last few weeks in year 3 and 4, our teaching assistants have been running fun activity afternoons with some of our parents and their children.
