Goodnight Mr. Tom Book Review

From the moment you pick up this amazing book by Michelle Magorian, you will be mesmerised by the characters and storyline! The story is about a shy, young evacuee, named William Beech (or Willie to his friends) being sent to live in a small village called Little Weirwold in the Yorkshire Dales, to escape war-torn London during the Second World War.

At first, Willie, our main character, struggles to settle in as he has to live with an old, recluse by the name of Thomas Oakley (Mister Tom) who has a sad and upsetting past. Slowly, Willie learns to love his new environment and Mister Tom teaches him to read and write.

The main characters in the book are Willie, Mr Tom and Willie's close friends, Zachary Wrench, another evacuee sent to live in Little Weirwold, Ginnie and ??? (the twins) and their brother, George. However there is a vile and evil character in the book, which is Willie's mother, Mrs Beech, but we don't want to spoil the story for any readers, so we won't tell you much about her!

I think this book is a great read for anyone, however, I don't think that this book is suitable for children under 10 years old, as some of the scenes are quite upsetting and traumatic, however, the end of the book will have you crying with happiness!
