**H**ave you heard of Matilda? The Twits? Esio Trot? All of these brilliant books were written by one man, Roald Dahl and this year would have been his 100th birthday! Unfortunately though, Dahl died in 1990 at the age of 74.

Born in Wales in 1916, Dahl was the son of Norwegian parents, Ronald and Sofie. His early years were spent in boarding schools after his father had died and this is where Dahl started to create some of his amazing characters and ideas for his books.

During the Second World War, Dahl became a fighter pilot in the Royal Air Force, unfortunately, Dahl was shot down in his plane and suffered head injuries meaning he would no longer be able to be a fighter pilot.

In 1961, Dahl published his first book, James and the Giant Peach before publishing greats such as; Charlie and The Chocolate Factory and Fantastic Mr Fox.



All these wonderful books were written in Dahl's little garden shed found at the bottom of his garden, where his wife would bring him tea and biscuits each day to fuel his passion for writing!

Although Dahl died in 1990, his books are still read and loved today by children from all over the world and are still being made into major blockbuster films such as The BFG!
